# 2019 WARRIOR INVITATIONAL RULES

Thank you for joining us in the inaugural edition of the Warrior Invitational. Tournament rules will be as follows:

## FORMAT:

All teams are guaranteed 4 matches. There will be two groups of four teams. Ten-point system will be used during the group stage. Group winners will play the championship match. 2nd place finishers in the group will play each other in the third-place match. 3rd and 4th place finishers in the group will play a consolation match.

**MEDICAL:** Teams are to provide for their own medical care. There will be NO trainer on duty.

## MATCH LENGTH:

Matches on Thursday and Friday will be regulation 40-minute halves.

Pool play matches may end in a draw.

All Saturday matches will be 35-minute halves with a 5-minute halftime.

Championship game will be 40-minute halves. If there is a draw at the end of the 3rd Place or Championship match, the winner will be decided by kicks from the mark.

## GROUP STAGES (10 POINT SYSTEM):

6 Points for a Win

3 Points for Tie

1 Point for a shut out (0-0 is not a shut out)

0 Points for a loss

1 Point per goal up to 3 goals maximum

\*1 point will be deducted for each Red Card received

## CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS:

Championship: 1st Place Points Black v 1st Place Points Red

Third Place: 2nd Place Points Black v 2nd Place Points Red

Consolation Match 2: 3rd Place Points Black v 3rd Place Points Red

Consolation Match 1: 4th Place Points Black v 4th Place Points Red

## POOL PLAY TIE BREAKERS:

1. Head to Head

2. Goal Difference

3. Shutout wins

4. Least Goals Allowed

5. Most Goals Scored

6. Coin Toss

\*Teams do not need to be present for the coin toss.

Coin toss will be done on the field immediately following the completion of the last group game.

**KICKOFF:** For Saturday Matches, the home team is listed first on the schedule and shall provide the soccer balls for the game and the Visiting team shall decide which side of the field they want to defend first. The home team will have choice of sidelines in the stadium.

**FORFEITS:** If a team forfeits a match, they will be responsible to pay the referee fees and will not be invited to future tournaments. All forfeits will be scored as a 2-0 victory for the other team. (9 points in group play)

**PROTESTS:** The referees and tournament director will have final decisions. There will be no protests.

**AWARDS:** Medals and Championship Plaque will be presented to the Tournament Champions. Plaques will also be presented to Finalists and Third Place finishers.
